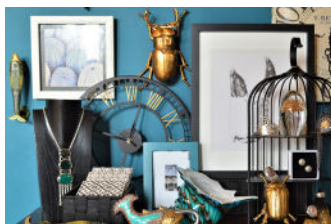

Take a journey around the outstanding scenery of the Isles of Mull and Iona, while soaking up the local culture, visiting artists and craftspeople in their studios and galleries.

For the first time, over 50 artists on Mull and Iona have joined together to invite visitors to have a first-hand experience of the vibrant island culture.

There are 25 venues taking part throughout the islands. Mull is a surprisingly big island and journey times on single track roads are longer, so make sure you can reach your preferred venues in good time, and check the opening days and times of each one. It takes around 1.5 hours to travel from Tobermory in the North, to Fionnphort in the South. The ferry to Iona departs from Fionnphort and takes around 10 minutes. See calmac.co.uk for timetables.
